## Annual Stickers or Punch Cards

### Required & Valid for Household Garbage Only

Garbage is generated by the day-to-day activities of a household. Use only 33 gallon bags or smaller for household garbage and put into the single trash compactor.

#### Examples of Household Garbage

Food Waste, Food Wrappers, Styrofoam Packaging, Kitchen & Cooking Waste, Bathroom Trash

#### Items prohibited from Household Garbage

Any items of hazardous nature such as flammables, pesticides, chemicals, gas cylinders; items must go to the Estuary Region Household Hazardous Waste Facility

## Textile Bins

## Betty Pierson Recycling Building

This area provides a drop off location for reusable items that residents want to offer to their neighbors. Wooden furniture, household items, bicycles, etc., in good condition, may be left here. Residents may take items for their personal use.

### Brush Disposal

Residents & Non-Profits	FREE
Commercial Haulers	\$ 10.00/yard

Brush <3 inch diameter ONLY

**Log Disposal** \$ 10.00/yard

Logs <12 inch diameter ONLY  
NO stumps accepted.

**Sleeper Furniture** \$ 20.00 each

**Stuffed Furniture** \$ 10.00 each

## Items Not Accepted

Gasoline or gasoline mixed with oil, wood preservatives or deck sealers, solvents, thinners or turpentine, gas cylinders, PBC-ballast light fixtures, explosives, pesticides, fertilizer, pesticides, chemicals.
