OLD BUSINESS

i. Main Street Essex - Monitoring Wells Report

Ms. Fasulo stated that the monitoring wells report is much improved compared to how it's been for the last five years or so. The monitoring well on Scholes Lane has shown significant improvement since the modifications to the septic system at The Griswold Inn were put in place in 2018.

ii. Cesspool Removal/Replacement Ordinance Action Steps

Ms. Fasulo believes that there are cesspools on 1, 3 and 5 Main Street, Essex. Ms. Fasulo has asked the property owner of 1 and 3 Main Street to investigate to determine if a septic tank is present. Ms. Fasulo is monitoring the situation. Ms. Fasulo also believes there may be a cesspool at 86 Dennison Road, she is investigating.

iii. Essex Village Data Collection

Previously discussed. Ms. Fasulo announced that she is actively seeking a replacement for Thad King who has accepted a position with the Eastern Highlands Health District

iv. Essex Yacht Club

Ms. Fasulo stated that they have finished installing their septic system but the hole created by a tent in the aeration system has not been repaired and therefore EYC has not been issued a permit to discharge.

Carlson's Landing permit to discharge can't be completed until Ms. Fasulo has the data from Geomatrix for their system.

v. New Tenants

Swanky's at 5 Main Street, Centerbrook and TownSoup (office) at 15A Main Street, Essex; Cait Shea (clothing retail) at 104 Main Street Ivoryton (in former Gather location)
